Women's Equality Day marks the adoption of the 19th Amendment, which prohibited states from denying the right to vote based on sex.

Women in Anesthesiology & Pain Medicine

<u>According to the AAMC</u>, 25% of active anesthesiologists in the US are women. Women in anesthesiology face disparities in academic, clinical, and research settings:

- Women comprise only 7% of full professors in academic anesthesiology departments, compared to 17% of men at the same rank.
- The proportion of female department chairs has remained stagnant at 13% over the last decade.
- Gender differences in compensation persist. Women anesthesiologists earn ~8%
 less compared to men in the same positions. (Anesth Analg 2021 Oct 1;133(4):1009-1018)
- Despite this, it is promising to see that 32% of residency program directors are women.

Improving the environment for women:

- While the proportion of women in medicine is increasing, institutional support and systemic change is needed for women to move into leadership positions.
- Institutional gender equity initiatives are needed to continue to decrease the gender salary gap and improve promotion disparities.
- Academics departments, including ours, are creating formalized mentoring and peer support programs for women to increase recruitment and retention.




