**1 in 6** LGBTQ adults reports avoiding health care due to anticipated discrimination – with transgender patients being the most likely to delay care

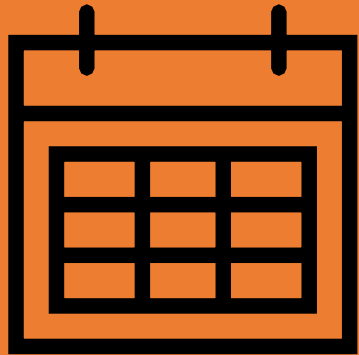

Emphasize the *individual*... NOT the group!

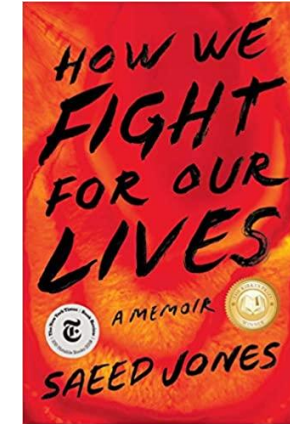
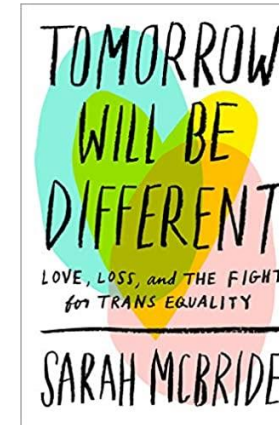
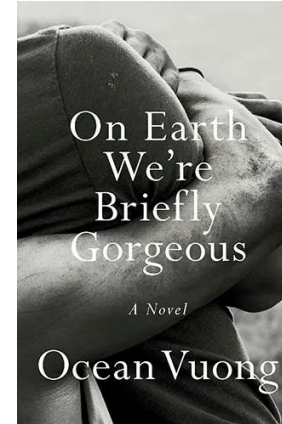
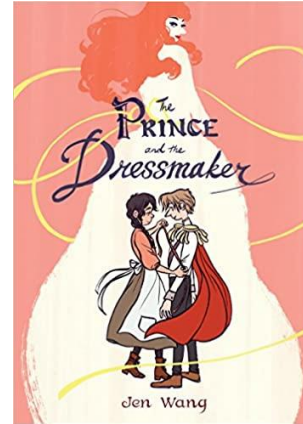
