LGBTQ+ Pride & Juneteenth

LGBTQ+ Rights in the United States

A police raid at <u>Stonewall Inn</u> on June 28, 1969, ignited the fight for <u>LGBTQ+ rights</u> in the United States. Over the last 50 years, the LGBTQ+ community has fought and won marriage rights and struck down laws prohibiting homosexual activity. The researchers of the Harvard Implicit Bias Study published results showing a 33% decrease in bias based on sexual orientation between 2007-2016.

The fight for LGBTQ+ rights continues despite massive gains. In 2023 alone, legislators have proposed <u>557 laws in 49 states</u> that would curtail access to gender-affirming care, ban LGBTQ+ content in schools, and criminalize drag performances. 87 have already passed. Earlier this year, Washington became a <u>sanctuary state</u> for transgender and abortion healthcare, furthering a commitment to bodily autonomy.

Juneteenth

On June 19, 1865, nearly two years after President Abraham Lincoln emancipated enslaved Africans in America, Union troops arrived in Galveston Bay, Texas with news of freedom. More than 250,000 African Americans embraced freedom by executive decree in what became known as <u>Juneteenth or Freedom Day</u>.

Juneteenth is the US's second Independence Day. Although it has long been celebrated in the African American community, this monumental event remains largely unknown to most Americans. The historical legacy of Juneteenth shows the value of never giving up hope in uncertain times.




